

SMA June 15, 2000 (Draft Mins from notes w/ additions)

Meeting called to order 7:22 PM

{Present were: Donna, Walter, Reneé, Hugh, Helen, and Linda; absent with excuse were: Alexis, Edwenna, and Archie; Absent were: David, Fritz and Virginia.}

Agenda approved unanimously.

Renee read minutes; motion to accept as read by Walter, seconded by Linda Murnik.

Hugh: \$2,188.46 in bank. Made up balance of account on computer. Budgeted by categories (income and expense items). IRS has received 501(c)4 application.

Linda and Hugh will miss July and Sept. meetings. Hugh will give Cerrillos mailbox key to Donna; will do July newsletter by computer. Somebody (pres.) will pick up newsletter at printers.

Walter reported PNM cut down trees on his road that would interfere with phone lines.

Reneé reported on mine tour. 8 people attended. New reverse osmosis system on top of overburden pile that cleans pit H2 is functioning; tailings piles beautifully landscaped.

Walter read letters he wrote to Sherriff's dept. re ATV attacks and sheriff's dept. lack of interest/action. To State Land Office: use of ATV on public land. Incident report attached to each letter; copy of letter to gov. also. Board approved letters and thanked Walter for writing them. Send copies to Mr. Von Kaenee.

Newsletter comments – took exception to open space/anti-fence article. Several letters were received and e-mails. Put letters in next newsletter.

Canyon Vista's appeal (behind Mark Simmons property) at CDRC Tues. May 30. Jeff Langford presented a letter at hearing to assure the developer doesn't circumvent regulations. Donna read letter. CDRC denied appeal. Board suggested letter be put on web site and article in newsletter about CDRC ruling.

Penny Green of the staff SF County Land Use Dept. will send agenda, invited board member to attend departmental/in house meetings. We need an "at large" person.

Fritz still has not contacted Board. Who is on RAC now? Pres. Will call to find out if he's attending RAC meetings.
