

SMA, May 18, 2000 7 P.M.

Called to order at 7:10 by Pres. Donna.

{ Present were: Donna, Walter, Reneé, Hugh, Helen, Edwenna, Virginia, Alexis, and Linds; Absent were: David, Fritz and Archie. }

Hugh reported on newsletter mailing. Cost was \$531.02 as is; with non-profit status it would cost \$312.73. Hugh reported \$2,407 in the treasury.

Renee reported on upcoming gold mine tour June 1, 1 – 4 PM; all the board is invited; meet at gate at 12:45 Thurs.; Edwenna will ask county mgr. Sam Montoya to come along.

Helen Boyce spoke of her impending resignation. Each member present expressed their disappointment and tried to change her mind.

Rick Von Kaenee told of ATV's using state land more than ever at end of 44 and South Fork. They beat him up. Helen suggested he contact (the lessee) Jarred West. Walter said he had contacted Mr. West in the past when he planned to fence the 640 acre plot to get better control of area, with access to horsemen. (It is up to lease holder to control access.) It was once fenced and trespassers cut the fence. Sheriff has been called in the past and essentially did nothing. There was discussion by Hugh to send letter to sheriff, newspaper editors – take account – and write to *county commissioners and Liz Stephanics.” Breach of faith of public” – W.W. Investigate sheriff's lack of interest... *DA & Governor? Sheriff's office. Get account: how many? When? Time? Police case report no.? Why not ask sheriff to send 2 guys to their house? It will take pressure to get any action at county commission. How about banning ATV's from state land? Walter made motion that we write letter w/copies to county comm; Liz Stehanics, Phil Griego, DA, Governor and Sheriff's office re: lack of concern of sheriff's dept. of ATV trespass & physical assault and intimidation; ATV's on state land. Hugh seconds. Motion passed unanimously.
