

PROPOSED NEW ANIMAL ORDINANCE

THE County is proposing a new Animal Ordinance that will greatly change the cost of animal licensing in Santa Fe County, and will increase fines and penalties for a variety of “offenses”. CATS would be required to wear collars and Tags.

It would make it illegal for your dog or cat to be “off-leash” on your property, would require a \$200 annual fee if you had “more than ten animals”, and would cost \$100 per year for each unfixed animal found on your property. It would require your vet to report your name and address to Animal Control each time you got your animal a rabies shot. They want to insure that they get their \$8.00 annual license fee from you!
